

Tax Document Checklist: Self-Employment

Required Documents

- Social Security Cards or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) Cards/Letters for each person on the tax return
- Photo I.D. for taxpayer and spouse (if applicable)
- 1095-A, if taxpayer purchased health insurance through Connect for Health Colorado
- If filing jointly, spouse must be present to sign e-file paperwork

Income

- 1099-NEC
- 1099-K
- Total of Income not reported on those forms, such as cash payments
- Portal information from apps such as Uber and Lyft

Expenses

- Advertising
- Car and Truck Expenses

- Year Placed in Service: _____
- Commuting Miles: _____
- Insurance (Other than health)
- Legal or Professional Services

Estimated Tax Payments

- Total amount paid in estimated tax payments

Due to IRS regulations, IRS-Certified volunteers cannot prepare returns with the following characteristics:

- Business income with a net loss
- Expenses over \$35,000
- Vehicle expenses reported as actual income
- Expenses for employees
- Contract labor
- Business use of home
- Casualty losses
- Cost of goods sold (inventory)
- Return and allowances
- Rental properties, including AirBNB
- Income from controlled substances, such as marijuana
